Description and Responsibilities

If you have a special skill or talent that you would like to share with youth or adults, you can teach a class or workshop. Possible classes include music, art, and other recreational skills. Class/Program Instructors enjoy the ability to teach and engage others in activities that they have a passion for.

Requirements:

Must be at least 18 years of age, must provide three references relative to the class/program desired; Minimum time commitment: 10 hours

Bilingual in English and Spanish a plus

Duties may include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Organizes and instructs a specialized enrichment class or program, developing specific program outcomes.
- Explains and demonstrates instructional techniques to participants.
- Ensures that participants are engaged and that the class abides by industry standards relative to the subject area.
- Motivates all class participants to accomplish the program or personal goals.
- Prepares instructional materials and supplies. Sets up and cleans up room/area. Distributes, collects, inspects, and accounts for equipment. Demonstrates proper use of equipment.
- Provides excellent customer service, to include professionally and politely communicating with participants, parents, and teammates.
- Responds calmly and efficiently in emergency situations.
- Observes and enforces safety regulations to secure safety of activity, participants and spectators.
- Assists patrons and participants with information as needed.
