Description and Responsibilities

Youth Development Volunteers have 3 different locations/areas they can choose to volunteer with. Each provides various levels of programming to their participants from game nights, sports, science, and more. Volunteers will be dedicated to assisting teammates with their specific enrichment programs on an as needed basis.

Requirements:

Minimum 15 years old, completion of mandated reporter training,
fingerprinting/background check
Minimum time commitment: Varies

Duties may include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Assists in the planning and delivery of youth enrichment programs.
- Follows and gives verbal and written directions.
- Supervises program activities and participants.
- Maintains facility and equipment in a clean and orderly manner.
- Responds calmly and efficiently in all situations, including emergencies.
- Observes and enforces safety regulations to secure safety of activity, participants and spectators.
- Provides excellent customer service, to include professionally and politely communicating with participants, parents, and teammates.
- Maintains order, discipline and good public relations.
