



Parks Volunteer

Description and Responsibilities

Parks Volunteers may assist with general cleanup and janitorial of parks, landscaping, and general parks maintenance. Primary areas of focus include Vista Montana LLMAD and various additional parks.

Requirements:

Minimum age 15 years old, fingerprinting/background check
Minimum time commitment: Varies

Duties may include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Waters, mows, rakes and edges lawns and turfs; renovates grass and lawn areas.
- Plants, cultivates, trims, waters, and sprays ornamental plants, shrubs, hedges, trees and flowers; prepares soil for planting; operates trailer-mounted watering equipment.
- Weeds planters, tree wells, sports fields, other parks and public grounds areas.
- Uses general groundskeeping, carpentry and mechanical tools such as picks, shovels, hoes, rakes, shears, edgers, loppers, saws, drills, wrenches, screwdrivers and hammers.
- Performs graffiti and debris cleanup.
- Waters, rakes and drags tools/equipment in maintaining level playing surfaces for sports league games; chalks and sprays lines on fields for games.
